Distance Learning for Week of January 5-8

As the holiday season comes to a close, we understand that as much as we all tried to stay safe, with holidays come family gatherings and out-of-state vacations. Because of this, we have decided to give students a week of distance learning to ensure good health when they return to campus on January 11th.

The schedule for the week is below. Please be sure your child is present and on-time for all classes as attendance is mandatory. Students should log in to their first class by 8:25 am as late students will be marked absent. Please note that since Monday is a teacher workday and students have no school, Wednesday will be the same schedule as Tuesday, Thursday & Friday. There will be no elective classes this week.

Reminders...

• Students must be in uniform with cameras turned on. If the camera is not on, the student will be marked absent and lose points.

• If students are late for their class, and we do not hear from them with a valid reason, they will be marked absent and lose points.

** As a precaution, if your child has traveled during the holidays, we ask that they would remain off-campus for 10-days following their return, even with a negative COVID test. Please let us know as soon as possible if your child will need to continue distance-learning beyond January 8th so we can make the necessary arrangements.
